This year at BCNC Quincy

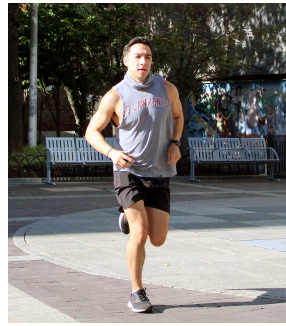
- 72 youth engage in leadership programs and received college application and financial aid support
